Y Inclusion

Children with special needs succeed in group care settings with specialized inclusion and family support services. Y Inclusion offers these exceptional kids the priceless experience of interacting with and being accepted by their peers while providing parents with the peace of mind their children can become healthy and happy members of the community.

New Horizons

Adults with developmental disabilities typically go through life feeling isolated and alone. New Horizons provides supervised recreational outings that offer social interaction, skill building, and life-long friendships for these exceptional individuals. While participants are having fun, their full-time caregivers are provided with the "time-off" they need to better care for their loved ones.

Foster Care Mentoring

Community volunteers provide hundreds of at-risk youth with fun activities and outings at monthly FUNDAYS, while providing a much needed break for the foster parents. For these children and families, our volunteers are our FACES OF HOPE, providing role models and the support they need to overcome their abusive past.

The YMCA of Orange County takes pride in the quality and accessibility of its afterschool programs; we believe all children and families, regardless of income, should have access to licensed and accredited programs. In California, 41% of children are without adult supervision after school. During these hours, youth are at a greater risk of involvement in crime, drug abuse and other destructive behaviors. We are committed to assisting families in need of a safe and engaging setting for their children while they are at work through our Partner's Campaign.

As the largest licensed provider of School Age Care in Orange County, the YMCA serves over 3500 children in afterschool programs.



250 families were served with **\$400,000** in assistance last year thanks to the generosity of **Orange County** community contributions.
