What is the Early Childhood Program?

The ECP provides mental health services in the pre-school setting to children 0-5 and their families who are eligible for Medi-Cal insurance.

The mental health specialists provide their services via telephone consultations, on-site in the child's home or preschool, and through community advocacy and linkages in English and Spanish.

- Provide early intervention services in order to keep children in childcare.
- Help ensure Orange County's children enter school healthy, developmentally on target and ready to learn.
- Help children develop to their fullest potential.

Our services include:

- Developmental Assessment
- Intervention Planning

- Case Management Services

Eligibility:

- Child needs to be eligible for Medi-Cal Mental Health Services (EPSDT)
- Children from birth to 5 years
- Child experiencing behavioral or emotional difficulties
- Child has difficulties in maintaining pre-school enrolment
- Child and Caregivers experiencing difficulties in foster and relative care replacement
