## Mentoring

- Serves current and former foster youth throughout Orange County who are between the ages 6-17.
- Community Based Mentoring - Pairs youth with a positive role model to explore the community and build life skills.
  - Academic Mentoring - Pairs youth with a tutor to enhance study skills and provide academic assistance.
- FunDays are no cost and are one Saturday per month - Gives youth the opportunity to have a fun day at the aquarium, amusement park, carnival, or any fun activity while being paired with a volunteer for the day.
- Provides many volunteer and internship opportunities (must be 18 years or older to volunteer.)

### What do we provide?

- Provides youth with community based mentors to be a consistent positive role model for a minimum of 8 hours per month for one year.
- Provides academic mentors to assist youth with homework and study skills for an hour a week for 6 months.
- Provides monthly FunDays at no cost for youth to enjoy a Saturday at a carnival, aquarium, bowling alley, museum, and many more fun places in the community.
- Ongoing screening and training for mentors to ensure safety of youth matched.
- Ongoing case management and resources for families in our programs.
- Rewarding volunteer opportunities with various time commitments for adults age 18 and older.
