• Steps to Inclusion

- Referral from the Regional Center of Orange County.
- Complete behavioral assessment.
- Placement in After School Child Care
- Continued supervision and on-site support.

Y Inclusion Onsite Inclusion Support

Experienced and trained inclusion facilitators provide ongoing 1:1,1:2,1:3,1:4 (adult:child support).

• Family Support Services

Families may receive support services from our Behavioral Specialist. Services include program consultations, progress reviews, and placement assistance in preschool, childcare, and after school care programs.

• Staff Training

Ongoing staff training is provided to our staff periodically.

• Assessment of Children's Inclusion needs

An assessment is carried out to determine the most appropriate services for each child.

• Consultation

Onsite consultation is provided to address behavioral concerns, inclusion plans and other related needs.

Our Promise

To keep programs open to all.

To keep that promise - to keep programs open to all - the YMCA of Orange County reaches out to members and supporters in the community to raise funds for financial assistance or to make programs available at little or no cost when needed.

Last year, the YMCA raised over \$1.7 million dollars that made over 1,600 scholarships available for all YMCA programs such as child care and camp, as well as allowing free and reduced fee programs in areas including teen leadership and afterschool enrichment.

In addition to our traditional services, the YMCA Community Services Division provides three core programs - Foster Care Mentoring - New Horizons - Y Inclusion - that reach out with special services to make sure that YMCA programs are there to serve the needs of those with the greatest needs in our communities.
