### **How Big Is Camp E.L.K.?**

Camp E.L.K. is 8.8 acres located outside of Wrightwood, CA. Camp enrollment is limited to 80 campers each session to ensure quality and individual attention. Junior Camp (5-8 year olds) is limited to 40 campers and L.I.T. in Session 2 (15-17 year olds) is limited to 20 campers.

### **Where Do Children Sleep?**

Campers sleep in bunk beds in cabins with 9 other campers of the same age and 2 or 3 counselors. Campers bring their own sleeping bags.

### **Can My Child Request A Friend In The Cabin?**

Yes. Our registration form allows you to request one other camper to be in your child's cabin. The request must be reciprocated by the other parent and campers must be of the same age and gender.

### **Where Do Campers Come From Who Attend Camp E.L.K.?**

Camp is promoted throughout Orange County, Riverside County, San Gabriel Valley, San Bernardino County and the High Desert.

### **Who Is Your Staff?**

We carefully screen and vet each candidate. Staff members are selected for their skills, enthusiasm for working with children, and ability to serve as great role models. All staff complete over 50 hours of orientation before the summer and we have over 50% staff return rate!

### **What Kind Of Food Do You Serve?**

Camp E.L.K. provides nutritious camp food and snacks. Every meal has options like a salad or cereal bar. We can accommodate most dietary requirements and allergies.

### **What Activities Will My Child Do?**

Archery, low ropes, hiking, swimming, arts and crafts are just a few. Some activities are designated for older groups such as mountain biking. Younger campers have age appropriate fun and look forward to this activity when they return!

### **Are You Prepared For Emergencies?**

Camp has a developed Emergency Action Plans that all staff are trained and drilled on. All staff hold safety certifications (i.e. CPR, Wilderness First Aid, Lifeguard Certification) and a Health Center Supervisor lives on site. The closest hospital is 39 miles away in Victorville, CA.

### **What Is Sold At The Camp Store?**

We sell items to help kids remember camp like sweatshirts, flashlights, and backpacks. We do not sell food. A \$25 deposit is suggested for your child to spend while at camp.
